Dear Mr Rush

Re: Notice of Intention Special Rate Variation – 2018/19 and 2019/20

Please be advised that following a resolution from Council's Ordinary Meeting held in November 2017, Ballina Shire Council has confirmed its intention to make application for a special rate variation to the rate peg cap.

The application is for a variation for two years with the total rate peg cap, if the application was to be successful, being 9.3% in 2018/19 and 5.9% in 2019/20 (including the IPART determined rate peg of 2.3% for 2018/19 and estimated 2.5% for 2019/20).

The application will be made under section 508A and be a permanent increase to the notional yield.

The purpose of the special variation is infrastructure asset renewal and actions to improve the health of waterways.
