

WaterNSW Annual Review for 2023-24 – Correction to the Final Report

What is this about?

The purpose of this factsheet is to correct an error that was presented in the [Final Report](#) for the Annual Review of WaterNSW's regulated charges for rural bulk water services in the Murray-Darling Basin and rural customers in the Fish River Water Supply Scheme (FRWSS) for the 2023-24 period.

The error relates to the second-tier usage charge (i.e. usage in excess of minimum annual quantity or MAQ) for bulk filtered water for minor customers in the FRWSS that will apply in 2023-24.

This charge was incorrectly presented in the Final Report as \$1.57 per kL. This error appears in Table 4.3 of the Final Report.

The correct second tier usage charge for bulk filtered water for minor customers in the FRWSS that will apply in 2023-24 is **\$1.56 per kL**.

Why did it happen?

This presentational error was the result of incorrect application of the Consumer Price Index (CPI) to inflate charges from those presented in the [2021 Determination](#) (in this case \$2021-22) to the year in which these charges apply (in this case \$2023-24). This is based on actual inflation as measured by changes in the CPI. This error was specific to this charge and did not affect any of the other charges presented in the Final Report.

Who will be affected?

The correction is relevant to any minor customers of bulk filtered water in the FRWSS who will use water in excess of their MAQ in 2023-24.

When will it apply?

The 2023-24 charges will apply from 1 July 2023 to 30 June 2024.
