The Independent Pricing and Regulatory Tribunal (**IPART**) grants the scheme approval for the Box Hill scheme under Schedule 4, clause 10(1) of the *Water Industry Competition Act 2006* (**Act**).

Approval Terms

Grant and authorisation

1.1 The Independent Pricing and Regulatory Tribunal grants this approval under the Act, Schedule 4, clause 10(1).

Note: This approval is deemed to be an approval granted under section 7B of the Act.

1.2 This approval authorises the registered operator to construct the authorised infrastructure for the authorised purposes in the area of operations in accordance with the specifications set out in this approval.

Note: This clause authorises the registered operator to carry out certain activities that would otherwise be prohibited under section 6 of the Act. This authorisation does not provide an exemption from obligations under other laws unless expressly provided by those laws.

2. Approval conditions

2.1 The authorisation in this approval is subject to the standard approval conditions specified in Schedule G, Item G2 and the special approval conditions specified in Schedule G, Item G3.

Note: The Act and Regulation contain additional conditions.

3. Interpretation

- 3.1 Expressions used in this approval that are defined in the Act or Regulations have the meanings set out in the Act or the Regulation unless the context otherwise requires.
- 3.2 In this approval, unless the context otherwise requires:
 - a. the singular includes the plural and vice versa,
 - b. a reference to this approval includes any schedule to this approval,
 - c. a reference to a schedule is to a schedule to this approval, and
 - d. explanatory notes and headings do not form part of this approval, but in the case of uncertainty may be relied on for interpretation purposes.
- 3.3 In this approval:

Act means the Water Industry Competition Act 2006.

area of operations means the area specified in the approval authorisation table.

authorised infrastructure means the water industry infrastructure specified in the approval authorisation table, including (as specified):

- a. authorised drinking water infrastructure,
- b. authorised sewage disposal infrastructure, and
- c. authorised recycled water infrastructure.



Item D1 Specified infrastructure

The following sewerage infrastructure used, or to be used, for or in connection with the collection and treatment of sewage for the production, supply and use of recycled water:

- (a) sewage reticulation network and pumping stations,
- (b) storage tanks, and
- (c) treatment plant and ancillary infrastructure.

Item D2 Authorised purposes

The authorised purposes for which the sewerage infrastructure specified in Item D1 is intended to be operated are the:

- (a) production of recycled water from sewage,
- (b) treatment of sewage,
- (c) filtration of sewage,
- (d) storage of sewage,
- (e) conveyance of sewage.

Schedule E Authorised recycled water infrastructure

Item E1 Specified infrastructure

The following water infrastructure used, or to be used, for or in connection with the collection and treatment of sewage for the production, supply and use of recycled water:

- (a) treatment plant and ancillary infrastructure,
- (b) water reticulation network and pumping stations,
- (c) water storage tanks, and
- (d) infrastructure for the further chlorination of recycled water.

Item E2 Authorised purposes

The authorised purposes for which the recycled water infrastructure specified in Item E1 is intended to be operated are the:

- (a) production of recycled water from sewage,
- (b) treatment of recycled water,
- (c) filtration of recycled water,
- (d) storage of recycled water, and
- (e) conveyance of recycled water, and
- (f) supply of recycled water to customers.

Schedule GApproval conditions

Item G1 Interpretation

If any condition, or part of any condition, is unlawful, that condition, or part of the condition, is severable and does not affect the validity of the approval or the balance of the conditions or condition.

Item G2 Standard approval conditions

G2.1 Maintaining appropriate insurance - design phase

- 2.1.1 The registered operator must hold, or ensure that any person it engages to design water industry infrastructure for the scheme holds, professional indemnity insurance in relation to the scheme during the design phase and for a minimum of 6 years from the date of the completion of the design phase.
- 2.1.2 In this condition G2.1, **design phase** means the period during which any design works are carried out in relation to the water industry infrastructure for the scheme.

Item G3 Special approval conditions

G3.1 Infrastructure designed and constructed to be fit for end-uses

3.1.1 The registered operator must ensure the water industry infrastructure for the scheme is designed and constructed to enable the supply of recycled water that is fit for the enduses specified in Table G3.1 below.

Table G3.1

- 1. Car washing
- 2. Clothes washing (cold water tap only)
- 3. Dust suppression
- 4. General wash-down
- 5. Irrigation
- 6. Ornamental water features
- 7. Process water at recycled water treatment plant
- 8. Street cleaning
- 9. Toilet flushing

- 3.1.2 In this condition G3.1, ornamental water feature means a water feature that:
 - (a) is provided primarily for aesthetic or beautification purposes, and
 - (b) does not, by its design or accessibility, encourage interaction with the water.

G3.2 Environmental risk mitigation measures

- 3.2.1 The registered operator must implement environmental risk mitigation measures substantially consistent with the environmental risk mitigation measures identified in the REF where the registered operator carries out any activities authorised by this approval.
- 3.2.2 In this condition G3.2, REF means the documents titled:
 - (a) "Review of Environmental Factors for the Proposed Sewage, Recycled Water Reticulation Systems, Box Hill North Precinct New South Wales", Version 7, prepared by RPS Australia East Pty Ltd and dated March 2016;
 - (b) "Review of Environmental Factors for the Proposed Local Water Centre, Box Hill North Precinct New South Wales", Version 4, prepared by RPS Australia East Pty Ltd and dated March 2016; and
 - (c) "Environmental Impact Assessment Checklist, Box Hill extension of recycled water reticulation", Revision 2.0, prepared by Flow Systems Pty Ltd and dated 6 October 2020,

and does not include any modified version of those documents or any documents replacing them.

G3.3 Construction Environmental Management Plan

- 3.3.1 The registered operator must ensure that the construction of any authorised infrastructure is carried out in accordance with the construction environmental management plan.
- 3.3.2 In this condition G3.3:
 - (a) **construction environmental management plan** means a site or project specific plan which:
 - (i) complies with the basic structure detailed in the environmental management plan guidelines; and
 - (ii) identifies how the licensee will implement the environmental risk mitigation measures identified in the REF to the extent they relate to construction.
 - (b) **environmental management plan guidelines** means the document titled *Guideline for the Preparation of Environmental Management Plans*, 2004, published by the Department of Infrastructure, Planning and Natural Resources that provides guidance to stakeholders preparing environmental management plans for environmental impact assessments and approvals under the *Environmental Planning and Assessment Act* 1979.

G3.4 [Not applicable]

G3.5 Limitations on infrastructure

- 3.5.1 The registered operator must not commence construction of the infrastructure specified in Schedule D and Schedule E in excess of capacity of 3.300 equivalent tenements, until after the registered operator has provided a report on the registered operator's proposed strategy for managing excess recycled water to be produced by that infrastructure, and IPART has provided written approval of the report.
- 3.5.2 The report referred to in condition 3.5.1:
 - (a) must be prepared by a suitably qualified person;
 - (b) identify and analyse reasonably available disposal/reuse options, including appropriate facilities; and
 - (c) recommend a preferred approach that will deliver the most efficient outcome having regard to financial and economic considerations.
- 3.5.3 In this condition G3.5, **appropriate facilities** means, as applicable, facilities with the capacity to accept:
 - (a) sludge and/or sludge cake produced by the infrastructure specified in Schedule D; or
 - (b) excess recycled water produced by the infrastructure specified in Schedule E.
