Your submission for this review:

I recommend that the Senior's Opal card metropolitan maximum fare of \$2.50 should not extend beyond Hornsby/Berowra (or similar), Waterfall, Campbeltown etc. I am a holder of one, and do not see why we should have to be subsidised by regular fare payers in travelling to Kiama, Newcastle or Mt Victoria, on that same fare. There cost to those limits of the system should be double what's involved in say a return trip from Mortdale to the City, for example. There could be a mileage factor in deciding new fare limits of \$3 to \$5 (maximum), and still be superb value, such that its reasonableness won't be met with howls of protest.
