INDEPENDENT PRICING & REGULATORY TRIBUNAL
DEAR SIR/MADAM,

I AM WRITING TO YOU IN REGARD TO THE PROPOSED 20% RATE INCREASE BY THE BELLINGEN SHIRE COUNCIL. I HAVE BEEN A RATE PAYER TO THIS COUNCIL FOR THE LAST 44 YEARS. I LIVE 38 KILOMETERS OUT FROM THE TOWN OF BELLINGEN & OF THE 38 KILOMETERS 15 GRAVEL ROAD BEING THE LAST STRETCH TO MY PROPERTY THERE ARE 14 LOW LYING BRIDGES TO CROSS ALONG THE DARKWOOD RD, IN TIMES PAST COUNCIL SATISFACTORILY SERVICED & MAINTAINED THIS ROAD & BRIDGES. IN RECENT YEARS THIS AREA BEING RURAL ALONG WITH OTHER RURAL AREAS HAVE BEEN GREATLY NEGLECTED WITH LITTLE TO NO PERIODIC SERVICE & MAINTENANCE. COUNCIL IS ALWAYS USING THE EXCUSE THAT ITS TO EXPENSIVE TO MAINTAIN THESE RURAL AREAS, YET CONTINUE TO SPEND LARGE SUMS OF MONEY ON NON ESSENTIAL MATTERS. THEIR POLICY SEEMS TO BE WAIT UNTIL THERE IS A FLOOD & WE WILL APPLY FOR A GRANT. WHEN THEY DO GET THESE GRANTS, IT APPEARS THE MONEY IS NOT ALL SPENT FOR THE PURPOSE IT WAS GRANTED.

THERE ARE TO MANY HIGHLY PAID CHIEFS & NOT ENOUGH INDIANS. THE PEOPLE OF THIS SHIRE IN GENERAL ARE ALREADY STRUGGLING TO AFFORD THE COST OF RATES,

NOT TO MENTION THE INCREASED EXPENSE OF VEHICAL REPAIRS DUE TO INFERIOR MAINTENANCE OF ROADS & INFRASTRUCTURE,

IT'S DUE TO THE LACK OF PERIODIC MAINTENANCE MANAGEMENT THAT THE SHIRE'S ROADS & BRIDGES DETERIORATE SO BADLY & END UP AN EXPENSIVE PROBLEM E.G. THE DARKWOOD ROAD WITH ONLY 8 KILOMETERS OF GRAVEL ROAD HAS NOT BEEN GRADED IN OVER 2 YEARS OR HAD A BANK SLASHER TO MANAGE THE OUR GROWTH.

SOME REMEDIAL WORK DONE HAS BEEN BY INTERSTATE CONTRACTORS

1. TEAM FROM THE NORTHERN TERRITORY & ANOTHER BY A QUEENSLAND CONTRACTING COMPANY, NOT LOCAL WORKERS, WHY NOT PROVIDE LOCAL JOBS AT FAR LESS EXPENSE.

THOSE IN MANAGEMENT HAVE LOST TOUCH WITH THE PEOPLE WHO PAY THEIR SALARIES & PUT THEM IN TRUST TO PROVIDE ESSENTIAL SERVICES.

SHOULD THEY ACHIEVE THIS QUEST FOR A RATE RISE IT WILL ALSO MEAN A SALARY INCREASE, THEY ARE ALREADY OVERPAID.

CONSIDER THAT THE GENERAL MANAGERS REMUNERATION IS AROUND \$240,000 YR PLUS OTHER BENEFITS, COMPARE THIS TO THE AVERAGE WAGE BARNER & PENSIONERS' INCOME AT THE LOWER SCALE OF AROUND \$21,000 YR. NO WONDER WE ARE TREATED WITH CONTEMPT.

PREVIOUS COUNCILS THOUGH THE YEARS MANAGED THE ROADS & BRIDGES TO AN ACCEPTABLE STANDARDS, THEY WERE CONSCIENTIOUSLY DILIGENT IN THEIR MAINTENANCE MANAGEMENT. I HAVE LIVED IN THIS SHIRE LONG ENOUGH TO NOTICE THE DIFFERENCE, THOSE PAST COUNCILS MANAGED ON FAR LESS RESOURCES THAN WHAT IS AVAILABLE TO THE PRESENT COUNCIL.

FINALLY I ENCLOSE A NOTICE BOARD BILL SHOWING LOCAL DISCONTENT, OF WHICH I AGREE TOTALLY WITH ALL SEVEN POINTS OF ISSUE.

I TRUST THAT THE INDEPENDENT PRICING & REGULATORY TRIBUNAL WILL CAREFULLY CONSIDER HOW THEY VIEW COUNCILS REQUEST FOR A RATE RISE, IN FAIRNESS TO THE RATE PAYERS OF THIS SHIRE & THEIR GENERAL FEELINGS OF MISMANAGEMENT OF HOW OUR RATES ARE BEING SPENT.

Just say why you oppose the rate increase- only need to give one reason but can give more.

For example:

1. The majority of rate payers are struggling to pay their rates now.
2. Council has shown it can't spend money efficiently or effectively.
3. Management treats ratepayers with contempt.
4. Too many indoor staff eg. 2 assistant general managers.
5. Spends money on social issues that are not relevant to Council.
6. Accepts grants funding for projects that require ongoing maintenance at ratepayers expense Eg Hyde Street upgrade.
7. Have seen little from recent large special rate variations for roads.
