For your consideration: - The proposed increases are too high. If they go ahead, it will significantly negatively impact the sustainability of my small farming business, of which 50 ha is irrigated. - We have already seen significant increases to our cost of water in recent years and the increases are greater than the recoverable income we can generate from what we grow with the water. - Our town has already been decimated by the water buy backs under the MDBP and further farming enterprises having to cease operating due to the huge increases proposed in water costs, will again have an enormous flow on effect on our town's well being. - We don't understand what services we are paying for. Murray Irrigation provides many of the services that Water NSW provides to river pumpers. Why are we being charged for services we don't receive? We are not seeing customer value in the proposal. - We feel that the production of food and fibre for Australians should be prioritized, and farmers should be assisted by Government rather than increasingly pressured and stressed to try to produce more with less in a current economic environment of sky rocketing cost of living for everyone.
