Submission: I write in support of the merger of Leichhardt Council with one or more of the six inner west councils. I have been a rate payer to Leichhardt Council since 1989 and have encountered frustration with the DA for my own house and subsequent difficulty in support/opposing the DAs of other residents. The Councillors come and go, meetings not particularly well organised (in opposing a development encroaching on the small residence of an elderly lady, our case was heard past midnight on 2 separate occasions), and they do not manage decisions well, when there are significant conflicting views (trees in Illoura Reserve). I believe that some of the councillors are more concerned about local government as a stepping stone to state politics than addressing the needs of the residents. I watched the improvements made in Glebe to the ovals and parks when Glebe was taken from Leichhardt Council and incorporated into the City of Sydney.
