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Your submission for this review:

The Mamre Road Stormwater Scheme is the first to be developed in the Aerotropolis and can set the model for prioritising the health of waterways in this important catchment area, which is one of the most cleared in greater Sydney. The most important consideration in this Stormwater Scheme is to prioritise environmental benefits, including the cooling and greening of the area, which will contribute to making Parklands City a more liveable, socially richer city with a healthier community, which is integral to the objectives of the new city. Sydney Water's Stormwater Scheme, with recycling of stormwater, shallow retention basins and naturalised waterways and ponds, can provide benefits to protecting the waterway health of the Wianamatta/South Creek catchment. This is particularly key as South Creek is one of Western Sydney's longest waterways. The scheme has the potential to supply a majority of non-potable water needs in the precinct, taking a significant load off the drinking water supply for Sydney and furthering the aim of building a fully integrated water cycle management scheme.
