Your submission for this review:

Im writing this response on behalf of the Jerilderie Aquatic Club Inc. We are a small not-for-profit aquatic club based in Jerilderie New South Wales We encourage water skiing and other water activities for paying members We have a general security access license of 100 megalitres which we used to fill our man-made Lake. This lake is purely used for recreational activity. The lake also has significance to our local town for tourism as a place for travellers to rest. The proposed increases to Water charges we believe are completely excessive These will have a detrimental effect on the long-term sustainability of our aquatic club and ultimately the lake for the Water community We have no choice but to pay for our water to fill the lake as its the only supply and therefore have no choice but to pay the increased charges should they occur? Our club currently is balancing the cost of membership versus the ongoing costs to maintain the facilities Water delivery charges currently equate to around 8% of our yearly revenue , these increases will drive those costs up to being Around 18% of our costs. This is completely unsustainable for a not for profit organisation. It is extremely disappointing to see proposed increases like this at a time when cost of living is hurting all of society. We also fail to see any tangible benefit to our organisation from these extra charges. Our club believes that these fees and charges should only increase with CPI going forward.
