The end of 2013 saw a lot of work being completed all around the Shire.

- Road works on another section of the Legume to Woodenbong Road at Oaky Hill.
- Sealing of a section of the Mt Lindesay Road at Bald Rock turnoff.
- Completing Geyers Road causeway and planning Maryland River crossing on the Rivertree Road.
- Commenced the Main Street works on the corner of Manners & Rouse Street, in order to be ready for RMS in February 2014.
- Footpaths around the football oval and going out to Saddlers Estate will be completed when 2 footbridges are put over the Tenterfield Creek.

This year looks just as busy with early meetings planned with the State and Federal MPs trying to source funding for road works on the Legume to Woodenbong Road.

Council is also hoping for some news on the Plains Station Road for some funding to help maintain and improve this section of well used road.

## **SPECIAL RATES VARIATON**

Council, at its Ordinary Meeting of 27 November 2013, resolved to apply to IPART for a Special Rates Variation commencing in 2014/15 for a 4 year period. Council's submission will be for an Ordinary Rate increase of 1 year @ 15% + 3 years @ 10% including the normal rate peg increase. If successful, the additional income of \$9.1 Million raised over the next 10 years will assist Council to carry out essential Asset renewal identified in its Long Term Financial Plan and improve Councils financial sustainability. In 2014/15 an additional \$335,849 will be raised, depending on property land values, the Shire's 4,701 ratepayers will pay an additional \$71.30 on average per year or \$1.37 per week.
