WHAT

IPART is establishing a Technical and Audit Services Panel for audits of electricity networks. We seek applications from suitably qualified organisations to join the Panel.

The Panel will consist of pre-approved auditors who may audit different aspects of the electricity networks on behalf of IPART. Audits will generally assess compliance with one of the following:

- ▼ Safety management system requirements
- ▼ Critical infrastructure licence conditions including data security
- Reliability and performance licence conditions
- The NSW Department of Planning & Environment's Code of Practice for Authorised Network Operators
- ▼ Employment guarantees

WHO

Eligible applicants must have:

- ▼ Relevant audit/assurance experience
- Certification/experience in using one or more of the following standards: ASAE 3000, AS/NZS ISO 19011, ISAE 3000

- Sufficient insurance coverage as determined by IPART
- Ability to meet specific audit criteria for selected audit categories as set out in IPART's audit guidelines
- Resourcing capacity in terms of Lead Auditors, Auditors or Area Specialists
- Quality assurance systems/ procedures
 - Peer review processes
 - Quality frameworks such as ISO 9001: Quality Management Systems



HOW

Applicants must complete **Part A** and **Part B** of the application form available on IPART's website.

- ▼ Part A collects organisational information including experience, capacity and insurance details.
- ▼ PART B collects nominated individuals' information including experience.
