As an advocate for solar PV (not a salesperson) just an independant advisor i would like to let you know that almost every peson i speak to about solar is completely perplexed at how it is fair to sell electricity back into the grid at 6C per kWh and at the same time be charged up to 55c per kWh for electricity purchased.

I strongly support the following:

- That you support a fair price for solar at a minimum of 15cper kWh
- The feed-in tariff should increase in line with the wholesale price of electricity;
- The feed-in tariff should not just be a benchmark range, it should be regulated so retailers have to offer it as a minimum;
- The feed-in tariff should represent the true value of solar, this means recognising the environmental and health benefits and the network benefits of rooftop solar; and
