Impact on residential customers		
The main change we have made is for a higher water usage price and a lower water service charge. Do you agree with this? Any other comments on the draft prices?	These changes unfairly disadvantage renters (roughly 30% of HWC residential customers!), especially pensioners on fixed incomes. Renters should pay for their water use but by lowering the service charge, landlords have the reduced bill. I can assure you that this won't be passed on as a reduction in rents. Landlords make a windfall at the expense of renters further with the other reduced charges for stormwater and wastewater. Pensioner renters are already disadvantaged as they don't receive any rebate. To rectify this and compensate for the proposed changes it should be mandated that pensioner renters receive a rebate/discount.	
These prices are additional to the prices for water, wastewater and stormwater, and would be levied on all residential water customers. Any other comments on the draft discretionary prices?	These are welcomed and in fact should be greater for a greater range of potential efficiency (e.g. wastewater and stormwater harvesting) and amenity services.

The main changes we have made to price structures is a higher water usage price and a lower water service charge; and to no longer deem an amount of wastewater discharge. The increase in water usage price is not enough it does not discourage the use of high quality drinking water for other lower grade purposes nor encourage other lower quality water sources where appropriate.
