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Submission: I strongly believe that the original agreement should stand and Solo Water should discharge solely within the Beaches site (over areas 6 & 7) and no development of this area should be permissible. IF a change was ever to be considered, a Full and Independent Environmental Impact Assessment should be undertaken and they would need to prove that the pollution released would not affect the downstream environment. There are too many unknown factors such as the release of pharmaceuticals, plastics, hormones, minerals and metals that would be released into the creek system of the area, and this would make its way to the lagoon and onto the beach at Catherine Hill Bay, which is a well used, patrolled, swimming and surfing beach. No one wants the effluent from the Beaches estate on this beach. If they cannot control the waste internally, they need to make arrangements to have it pumped and removed by approved means, like many of the existing Catherine Hill Bay residents (ie Redmondis pump out trucks). Please let common sense prevail at some point, and refuse this amendment application. Some things are worth more than money can buy, and ensuring an effluent free Catherine Hill Bay is one of them.
