The Broken Hill water supply has always been assured by the flows that have come down the Darling river into the Menindee Lake system which was originally put in place to safeguard the towns water supply during dry spells - however, this flow of water no longer comes down the river due to upstream irrigators being allowed to over extract the fresh flow, leaving the Menindee Lake system sadly and wrongly depleted.

Consequently the water we currently have coming through our pipes is so putrid smelling like a cross between sewage/rotting leaf litter and chlorine that it is unfit to drink, let alone cook with or shower in.
