Submission: I have just received my first electricity bill since having a smart meter, set up for net metering, installed in early January. I was shocked to find out that my supplier, Origin Energy, were calculating the net amount of energy I use on an instantaneous basis. This resulted in the export or more accurately confiscation of 370kWhrs of solar power by Origin. I was still required to pay for 2029kWhrs of electricity for the quarter. The feed in tariff of 6c/kWhr is totally inequitable, given that the suppliers can sell this green energy for up to 30c/kWhr. If all retail power suppliers calculate net power use in this manner the proposed increase in the feed in tariff is more than justified.
