Submission: Dear Sir/Madam, I ask IPART to make a sensible increase to NSW residential providers of solar energy. While the initial heavily-subsidised payment of 68c per kwh was too generous, it did allow low-income households (including mine) to invest in solar panels, as the capital expense was repaid in 5 years of reduced electricity bills. However, in reducing the FIT to only 10% of the original payment, the power companies/regulators have gone too far in the other direction. I believe a FIT that's comparable to the charges for electricity coming from the grid would be fair to all and continue to encourage more people to adopt home solar systems now and in the future, reducing the nation's need for greenhouse gas producing fossil fuels of all kinds.
