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Submission: I am strenuously opposed to the discharge of any excess water into the environment as proposed by the variation application. The operator should retain responsibility for managing, on site, the output from its sewerage scheme, rather than place any risk of adverse impact on the fragile coastal environment and those many members of the public that enjoy the natural aspects of this special coastal location. Further, any variation to the operator's license would be a betrayal of public trust on the part of the regulator, as the development was approved upon the basis that no such discharge to the environment would occur.
