Fact Sheet – Transmission reliability standards

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IPART has been appointed by the NSW Government to review and recommend transmission reliability standards for TransGrid to commence 1 July 2018. As part of our review, we invite stakeholders to share their views with us.



In late 2013, the Australian Energy Market Commission (AEMC) recommended a national framework for setting reliability standards for transmission networks within the National Electricity Market (NEM). Among other things, this framework includes establishing reliability standards based on an economic assessment of different levels of reliability using the associated cost of investment and the value consumers place on reliability.



We invite all interested stakeholders to participate in our consultation process. This includes distribution network providers, customers with direct connections to the transmission network and end-users of electricity.

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After public consultation we will undertake an economic assessment of a number of reliability scenarios. Stakeholders will have further opportunities to provide comments when we release our draft decision in March 2016. We will also hold a public hearing in April 2016.

We will recommend reliability standards to the Minister for Industry, Resources and Energy in May 2016.
